



## CHAPTER 101

An Act to increase the powers of municipal corporations with respect to the building of sanitary houses

[Assented to, the 28th of April, 1939]

**HIS MAJESTY**, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

**1.** The Lieutenant-Governor in Council may, whenever he deems expedient and upon such conditions as he may fix, authorize any municipal corporation of a city, town or village to approve, in conformity with paragraph *a* of section 14 of the act of the Parliament of Canada 2 George VI, chapter 49, any project contemplated by the said section for the construction in its territory of low-rental dwelling houses.

Whenever a municipal corporation, after authorization by the Lieutenant-Governor in Council, has approved any such project for constructing dwelling houses, it may, and any school corporation, or corporation of trustees or *fabrique* of a parish having jurisdiction in the same territory may, grant to any limited-dividend housing corporation the commutations, remissions and exemptions of taxes and levies required by section 14 of the said act.

**2.** This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction.
