



CHAPTER 101

An Act to increase the powers of municipal corporations
with respect to the building of sanitary houses

[Assented to, the 28th of April, 1939]

HIS MAJESTY, with the advice and consent of the
Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly
of Quebec, enacts as follows:

1. The Lieutenant-Governor in Council may, whenever he deems expedient and upon such conditions as he may fix, authorize any municipal corporation of a city, town or village to approve, in conformity with paragraph *a* of section 14 of the act of the Parliament of Canada 2 George VI, chapter 49, any project contemplated by the said section for the construction in its territory of low-rental dwelling houses.

Whenever a municipal corporation, after authorization by the Lieutenant-Governor in Council, has approved any such project for constructing dwelling houses, it may, and any school corporation, or corporation of trustees or *fabrique* of a parish having jurisdiction in the same territory may, grant to any limited-dividend housing corporation the commutations, remissions and exemptions of taxes and levies required by section 14 of the said act.

2. This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction.
