



CHAPTER 105

An Act to amend the act 1 George VI, chapter 104, respecting the settlement of the tramway question in Montreal

[Assented to, the 28th of April, 1939]

HIS MAJESTY, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

1. The act 1 George VI, chapter 104, is amended by ^{1 Geo. VI, c. 104, s. 2a, added.} adding thereto, after section 2 thereof, the following section:

"2a. The members of the Committee, before entering ^{Oaths} into office, must take the following oath of allegiance and ^{obligatory.} that of office:

"OATH OF ALLEGIANCE

"I, A. B., do swear that I will be faithful and bear true ^{Form of oath.} allegiance to His Majesty (*name of the reigning Sovereign*), his heirs and successors, according to law. So help me God."

"OATH OF OFFICE

"I, A. B., do swear that I will fulfill the duties of my ^{Idem.} functions as member of the Investigating Committee formed in virtue of the act 1 George VI, chapter 104, honestly, faithfully and justly. So help me God."

These oaths shall be taken before a judge of the Superior ^{Where taken.} Court of the district of Montreal.

A duplicate of the taking of such oaths shall be tran- ^{Transmitting of duplicate.} smitted without delay to the Attorney-General."

2. The said act is amended by replacing sections 11 and 12 thereof by the following sections: ^{1 Geo. VI, c. 104, ss. 11, 12, replaced.}

Value of
written
decision.

"11. A written decision, signed by at least four members in office of the Committee shall have the same value as a resolution adopted at a regular sitting.

Making of
reports.

"12. The Committee must make such reports as may be required of it, to the Lieutenant-Governor in Council, at such times as the latter may fix.

Proceedings
not to be
hindered, etc.

"12a. No writ of injunction or of prohibition nor any other judicial proceeding whatsoever shall hinder or stop the proceedings of the Committee, of its members or of its employees."

Coming into
force.

3. This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction.
