



CHAPTER 118

An Act to amend the charter of the town of East Angus

[Assented to, the 28th of April, 1939]

WHEREAS the town of East Angus has, by its petition, Preamble.
represented:

That, in the interest of the ratepayers and the proper administration of its affairs, it is expedient to grant it more ample powers than those it already possesses under the authority of its charter, the act 2 George V, chapter 72, as amended by the acts 10 George V, chapter 102, and 21 George V, chapter 133, and also to make new amendments, for the said town, to the Cities and Towns' Act, and for other purposes; and

Whereas it is expedient to grant its prayer;

Therefore, His Majesty, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

1. Section 372 of the Cities and Towns' Act (Revised R.S., c. 102,

2. All the immoveable property of the Brompton Pulp Assessing of
