



## CHAPTER 128

### An Act respecting the corporation of the parish of St. Nicolas-Sud

*[Assented to, the 28th of April, 1939]*

**HIS MAJESTY**, with the advice and consent of the  
Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly  
of Quebec, enacts as follows:

**1.** Notwithstanding any general law or special act to the contrary, the resolution of the council of the parish of St. Nicolas-Sud, county of Levis, adopted on the 21st of December, 1938, ordering a temporary loan to the amount of five thousand five hundred dollars to pay the cost of straightening a portion of highway No. 4, is valid and sufficient to permit such municipal council to perform such work and borrow such sum, and no recourse at law may be exercised or continued against such municipal corporation or the members of its council consequent upon the adopting of such resolution.

**2.** The corporation of the parish of St. Nicolas-Sud alone shall be bound to pay, within the thirty days from the coming into force of this act, the taxable costs incurred prior to the 29th of March, 1939, in any suit brought consequent upon the adopting of the resolution mentioned in section 1.
