



CHAPTER 142

An Act to amend the charter of the Notre-Dame Hospital, Montreal

[Assented to, the 16th of March, 1939]

WHEREAS the Notre-Dame Hospital, a benevolent corporation of the city of Montreal, incorporated by the act 44-45 Victoria, chapter 48, and the amendments thereto: the acts 61 Victoria, chapter 82; 2 Edward VII, chapter 97; 7 Edward VII, chapter 121; 14 George V, chapter 117 and 24 George V, chapter 110, has, by its petition, prayed that its charter be again amended so that the board of management may of itself create, appoint and organize an executive committee and fix and determine its rights and powers; and

Whereas it is expedient to grant the prayer contained in the said petition;

Therefore, His Majesty, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

1. The act 61 Victoria, chapter 82, is amended by adding thereto, after section 8 thereof, the following:

“Sa. Without prejudice to the rights and powers conferred upon it by any prior law, the board of management alone may, in addition, at any time, create and appoint an executive committee composed of five (5) members of the board of management. This executive committee shall be answerable directly and exclusively to the board of management which, by resolution or by-law, shall establish the rights, powers and obligations of such executive committee and shall enact generally as regards the organization and working thereof.”

2. This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction.
