



CHAPTER 158

An Act to authorize the Bar of the Province of Quebec to admit Georges Albert Roy to the practice of the profession of advocate

[Assented to, the 30th of March, 1939]

WHEREAS Georges Albert Roy, law student, domiciled Preamble.
and residing in the city and district of Montreal,
has, by his petition represented:

That he is of age and a British subject;

That he obtained from the Faculty of Letters of the University of Paris, France, the degree of Bachelor in Philosophy and that this degree corresponds with the Baccalaureate in Arts of Montreal University;

That, on the 5th of November, 1935, he was admitted, by the Faculty of Law of the University of Paris, to the degree of licentiate in law and the licentiate in law of Paris University is the equivalent of the licentiate in law of Montreal University;

That he also holds a diploma from the *Ecole Libre des Sciences Politiques* of Paris;

That he had to study in Paris, as his father, the Honourable Philippe Roy, was Commissioner General and afterwards Minister Plenipotentiary for Canada, at Paris, during a period exceeding twenty-five years; but, being a British subject, he could not apply for admission to the Bar of Paris, nor to any French Bar;

That he now wishes to be admitted to the Bar of the Province of Quebec;

That the General Council of the Bar of the Province of Quebec, at a meeting held in Montreal on the 10th of De-

ember, 1938, approved and recommended the passing of an act to authorize the Bar of this Province to admit him to the practice of law, after he shall have successfully undergone an oral examination on the laws of the Province of Quebec; and

Whereas the said Georges Albert Roy has prayed for the passing of an act to the above effect and it is expedient to grant his prayer;

Therefore, His Majesty, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

Admission of
G. A. Roy by
Bar of P.Q.

1. The Bar of the Province of Quebec is authorized to admit the said Georges Albert Roy to the practice of law, after he shall have undergone successfully an oral examination only, before the Bar examiners, on the laws of the Province of Quebec.

Coming into

2. This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction.
