



## CHAPTER 161

An Act to authorize The Association of Optometrists and Opticians of the Province of Quebec to admit James S. Fontaine amongst its members, after examination

[Assented to, the 28th of April, 1939]

**WHEREAS** James S. Fontaine of the city of Trois-Rivières has trained himself in the profession of optometrist and optician by studying the principles of optometry and optics and by working, under the direction, on behalf of and in the well-patronized establishment of William Fontaine, optician of Trois-Rivières, during many years;

Whereas he possesses all the knowledge and qualifications required for the practice of the said profession;

Whereas he wishes to be member of The Association of Optometrists and Opticians of the Province of Quebec; and

Whereas he has prayed for the passing of an act for the above purpose, and it is expedient to grant his said prayer;

Therefore, His Majesty, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

**1.** The Association of Optometrists and Opticians of the Province of Quebec is authorized to admit amongst its members the said James S. Fontaine and to grant him a license to practise optometry in this Province, after an oral examination before the board of the said Association, and provided that the said James S. Fontaine continue his present studies during a period of six months counting from the 15th of March, 1939.
