



## CHAPTER 163

### An Act respecting the adoption of Marie Gabrielle Jeannette Lafontaine

*[Assented to, the 16th of March, 1939]*

**WHEREAS** Marie Guillemette, of the municipality of Preamble.

St. Romuald d'Etchemin, widow of Thomas Lafontaine, has, by her petition, represented that, before the Adoption Act was enacted, she had actually adopted Marie Gabrielle Jeannette Lafontaine, whom she has brought up as her own child, that she has provided for the support and education of the said Marie Gabrielle Jeannette Lafontaine, and that the latter and her husband, Donat Dussault, still live at the home of the petitioner; and

Whereas Marie Guillemette and her late husband Thomas Lafontaine, when they took Marie Gabrielle Jeannette Lafontaine under their care on the 7th of February, 1907, came and remained within the requirements of the Adoption Act; and

Whereas Marie Gabrielle Jeannette Lafontaine wishes to be adopted by Marie Guillemette and obtain ratification of her name; and

Whereas Marie Guillemette and Marie Gabrielle Jeannette Lafontaine have prayed for the passing of an act to such double effect; and

Whereas Donat Dussault, husband of Marie Gabrielle Jeannette Lafontaine, does not oppose the said petition; and

Whereas it is expedient to grant such prayer;

Therefore, His Majesty, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

**1.** The adoption of Marie Gabrielle Jeannette Lafontaine by Marie Guillemette is legalized counting from the 7th of February, 1907, and the said Marie Gabrielle Jeannette Lafontaine is deemed to be the adopted daughter of the said Marie Guillemette, enjoying from such date all the rights and privileges granted by the Adoption Act and shall have as her true name that of Marie Gabrielle Jeannette Lafontaine; but this shall in no way affect the rights which she may have hitherto acquired or may acquire in future, nor affect any obligation which she may have contracted or may subsequently contract.
