



## CHAPTER 2

An Act to increase the Provincial Farm Credit to twenty-five million dollars

*[Assented to, the 10th of February, 1938]*

**WHEREAS** it is of the greatest importance that the Preamble.  
Province of Quebec have an essentially agricultural character, considering that agriculture affords unrivalled elements of economic and social security and stability;

Whereas the aiding of agriculture means safeguarding the present and guaranteeing the future of the Province;

Therefore, His Majesty, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

**1.** The act 1 Edward VIII (2nd Session), chapter 3, Increasing of farm credit. establishing a farm credit to the amount of ten million dollars in the Province of Quebec, and the act 1 George VI, chapter 32, increasing such farm credit to fifteen million dollars, are amended by increasing to twenty-five million dollars the amount which the Quebec Farm Credit Bureau is authorized to lend to farmers under the said acts and by increasing accordingly the borrowing-power of the said Bureau.

**2.** Section 8 of the Quebec Farm Credit Act (1 Edward VIII (2nd Session), chapter 3), as amended by the 1 Ed. VIII (2nd Session), c. 3, s. 8, am. act 1 George VI, chapter 32, section 1, is again amended by replacing the word: "fifteen", in the first line of subparagraph *a* thereof, by the word: "twenty-five".

**3.** This act shall come into force on the day of its Coming into force. sanction.
