



## CHAPTER 6

### An Act to assist Verdun Protestant Hospital

*[Assented to, the 12th of April, 1938]*

**HIS MAJESTY**, with the advice and consent of the  
Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly  
of Quebec, enacts as follows:

- 1.** The Lieutenant-Governor in Council is authorized to guarantee, upon such conditions as he may determine and to the extent of a sum of seven hundred and fifty thousand dollars, the amount of any loan which Verdun Protestant Hospital may contract, by means of bonds or otherwise, for the enlarging of its hospital. Guaranteeing of loan of Verdun Protestant Hospital.
- 2.** He is also authorized to assume or guarantee the payment of the interest payable upon the amount so guaranteed. Assuming payment of interest.
- 3.** All sums which the Government may be called upon to pay in virtue of this act shall be taken out of the consolidated revenue fund. Payments out of con. rev. fund.
- 4.** This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction. Coming into force.
