



CHAPTER 13

An Act respecting the establishing of an agricultural school at Ville-Marie

[Assented to, the 8th of April, 1938]

WHEREAS the spreading of agricultural teaching in the Province is an eminently national work;

Whereas the creating of regional agricultural schools is one of the most suitable means of assuring the normal development of such work;

Whereas it is advisable to leave the management of such schools to the best educationalists of our people, the religious corporations;

Whereas it is expedient for the Province to contribute to a large extent to the establishing of a regional agricultural school at Ville-Marie;

Therefore, His Majesty, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

1. The Lieutenant-Governor in Council, upon the recommendation of the Minister of Agriculture, is authorized to enter into, upon such conditions as he may determine, with a religious corporation, an agreement with a view to the establishing and maintaining, at Ville-Marie, of a regional agricultural school, and to pay for such purpose to the said corporation, out of the consolidated revenue fund, during a period of five years, an annual subsidy of fifteen thousand dollars and a monthly allocation not exceeding nine dollars per pupil up to a number of sixty pupils.

2. This act shall be in effect as from the 1st of December, 1937.

3. This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction.
