



CHAPTER 14

An Act to provide for the establishing of mine-schools

[Assented to, the 8th of April, 1938]

WHEREAS it is expedient to afford youth every facility Preamble.
and the practical formation necessary to enable
them to profit from the careers open to them in the Provin-
cial mining field;

Therefore, His Majesty, with the advice and consent of
the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of
Quebec, enacts as follows:

1. The Lieutenant-Governor in Council may authorize Establishing,
etc., of mine-
schools.
the Minister of Mines and Fisheries to establish and main-
tain mine-schools at such places and upon such conditions
as he may determine, either upon Crown lands or upon land
acquired in virtue of section 2 of this act, and to effect the
expenditure required for their equipment and organiza-
tion.

2. The Lieutenant-Governor in Council may also au- Leasing, etc.,
of immove-
ables, etc.,
therefor.
thorize the Minister of Mines and Fisheries to lease or
acquire, by mutual agreement or by expropriation, the
immoveables and immoveable rights necessary for the
establishing of such mine-schools.

3. In order to assure the proper working of each of the Appointing,
etc., of su-
perintendent,
etc.
mine-schools organized under the authority of this act,
the Lieutenant-Governor in Council, upon the recommen-
dation of the Minister of Mines and Fisheries, may appoint
a superintendent, mining engineers, technicians, instructors
and all other necessary employees, and determine their
functions and fix their salaries or wages.

Entering into
certain
agreements.

4. The Lieutenant-Governor in Council may authorize the Minister of Mines and Fisheries to enter into agreements with third parties for the purpose of establishing and maintaining mine-schools.

Expenditure.

5. The expenditure incurred by the carrying out of this act shall be paid out of the monies voted each year by the Legislature for such purpose.

Retro-
activity.

6. This act shall be in effect as from the 1st of September, 1937.

Coming into
force.

7. This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction.
