



CHAPTER 15

An Act to provide for the establishing, at Quebec, of a mining, geological and metallurgical school

[Assented to, the 18th of March, 1938]

WHEREAS the mining industry in Quebec has recently made great strides; Preamble.

Whereas it is called upon, through the riches of Quebec's subsoil, to play a great role in the economic life of the Province and to open up interesting careers for our youth;

Whereas Laval University, the pioneer of professional teaching in Canada, wishes, by the establishing in the city of Quebec of a mining, geological and metallurgical school, to collaborate with the Government in the training of technicians in the mining industry, in geology and metallurgy, and whereas there is occasion to grant it reasonable financial assistance;

Therefore, His Majesty, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

1. The Lieutenant-Governor in Council, upon the recommendation of the Minister of Mines and Fisheries, is authorized to enter into an agreement with Laval University for the establishing and maintenance, at Quebec, of a mining, geological and metallurgical school and to pay to the said University for such purpose, out of the consolidated revenue fund, an annual subsidy of one hundred thousand dollars, upon such conditions as he may determine. Entering into certain agreement with Laval University authorized.

2. This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction. Coming into force.
