



CHAPTER 16

An Act to provide for the establishing of a school of higher studies in fishery

[Assented to, the 8th of April, 1938]

WHEREAS fisheries are an important resource of this Preamble.
Province and it is expedient to advance their development and procure the best possible return from them;

Whereas it is necessary to train experts in the practical utilization of the products and by-products from fishing;

Therefore, His Majesty, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

1. The Lieutenant-Governor in Council may, on the recommendation of the Minister of Mines and Fisheries, Organizing etc., of school of higher studies in fishery. enter into an agreement, with an educational establishment affiliated to one of the universities of this Province, for the organizing and maintenance of a school of higher studies in fishery with a view to afford training for the operating of fisheries and the utilizing of the products and by-products thereof, and pay to such school any subsidy annually voted for such purpose by the Legislature.

2. This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction. Coming into force.
