



CHAPTER 17

An Act to create a school of spinning

[Assented to, the 8th of April, 1938]

WHEREAS it is expedient to encourage the training Preamble.
of persons to become proficient in the textile
industry, in order to aid the establishing of youth and the
progress of this industry in the Province;

Whereas the establishing of a school of spinning will
greatly contribute towards the realizing of such an object;

Therefore, His Majesty, with the advice and consent of
the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of
Quebec, enacts as follows:

1. The Lieutenant-Governor in Council, upon the
recommendation of the Minister of Lands and Forests, is
authorized to enter into, upon such conditions as he may
determine, with any municipal corporation, educational
institution or other parties, an agreement for the establish-
ing and maintaining, in this Province, of a school of spinning
with a view to the training of persons to become proficient
in the textile industry. Entering into agreement for establishing, etc., of school of spinning.

2. The Lieutenant-Governor in Council is authorized
to expend, for such purpose, a sum not exceeding one hun-
dred thousand dollars, payable out of the consolidated
revenue fund. Amount that may be expended therefor.

3. Any municipal corporation which is a party to an
agreement entered into in virtue of section 1 shall possess
the necessary powers to carry it out and is authorized to
pay, out of its general funds, the expenditure incurred by
the carrying out of such agreement. Powers of certain municipal corporations.

Additional
powers.

Such corporation may, moreover, and notwithstanding any provision to the contrary of any general law or special act, borrow by resolution and without any approval other than that of the Minister of Municipal Affairs, Trade and Commerce and of the Quebec Municipal Commission, the sums necessary for the carrying out of such agreement.

Coming into
force.

4. This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction.
