



CHAPTER 21

An Act to provide for the fitting up of offices for
administrative services of the Government
in the Province

[Assented to, the 8th of April, 1938]

HIS MAJESTY, with the advice and consent of the
Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly
of Quebec, enacts as follows:

1. The Lieutenant-Governor in Council may authorize the Minister of Public Works to acquire, by private agreement or by expropriation, and to fit up, with a view to locating therein administrative services of the Government, the immoveables situated in the Province which he may deem necessary for such purposes.

He may also authorize the said Minister to acquire, by private agreement or by expropriation, lands situated in the Province and to erect and fit out buildings upon such lands for the same purposes.

Id., of lands.

2. The expenditure incurred for the carrying out of this act shall be paid out of the consolidated revenue fund.

Expenditure.

However, the Lieutenant-Governor in Council may authorize the Provincial Treasurer to pay, in whole or in part, such capital expenditure by means of loans not exceeding thirty years and at rates of interest not exceeding four per cent per annum.

Nevertheless, the total expenditure incurred under this act must not exceed one million five hundred thousand dollars and must be limited to one hundred and fifty thousand dollars per immovable.

3. The Minister of Public Works shall be charged with the carrying out of this act.

4. This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction.
