



CHAPTER 22

An Act respecting the Act 1 George VI, chapter 13

[Assented to, the 8th of April, 1938]

WHEREAS the application of the act 1 George VI, ^{Preamble.} chapter 13, may give rise to friction and problems difficult of solution, which it is expedient to avoid;

Whereas the present Government has appointed a committee of jurists to revise the laws of this Province and the selection of the members of such committee has earned for it the unanimous praise of the press, without distinction of race or party;

Whereas it is expedient to await the definitive reports of such committee in order to decide upon the matter contemplated by the said act I George VI, chapter 13;

Therefore, His Majesty, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

- 1.** The act 1 George VI, chapter 13, is repealed. 1 Geo. VI,
c. 13, re-
pealed.
- 2.** The provisions repealed or amended under the act 1 George VI, chapter 13, shall again have force and effect as they existed prior to the date of the sanction of the said act. Provisions
again in force.
- 3.** This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction. Coming into
force.
