



CHAPTER 33

An Act to amend Section 50 of the Lands and Forests Act

[Assented to, the 18th of March, 1938]

HIS MAJESTY, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

1. Section 50 of the Lands and Forests Act (Revised Statutes, 1925, chapter 44) is amended: R.S., c. 44,
s. 50, am.

a. By adding thereto, after the word: "may", in the sixth line of the first paragraph thereof, the words: ", by a petition duly served upon the occupant of the land with at least six full days notice of the date of its presentation,";

b. By adding thereto, after the first paragraph thereof, the following paragraph:

"Such petition shall be heard summarily, in term or out of term, on the date fixed by the notice or on any other subsequent date, as close thereto as possible, to which the judge may adjourn the hearing."; Hearing of
petition.

c. By replacing the words: "to deliver up the same", in the fifth and sixth lines of the second paragraph thereof, by the words: "to leave such land and deliver up possession of same";

d. By adding thereto, after the last paragraph thereof, the following paragraph:

"The proceedings contemplated in this section shall be deemed summary matters and the costs shall be those of a first class action in the District Magistrate's Court." Proceedings
