



CHAPTER 37

An Act to come to the assistance of agriculture in the counties of Argenteuil and Two Mountains

[Assented to, the 12th of April, 1938]

WHEREAS the population of the counties of Argenteuil Preamble.
and Two Mountains consists almost entirely of
farmers;

Whereas through the geographical position of these two
counties, the main public road leading to the Montreal
market is impeded by the St. Eustache toll-bridge known
as "Bellefeuille's Bridge";

Whereas for some years past, the cost of constructing the
bridge and the buildings connected therewith has been
entirely paid out of the returns to which the population of
both counties has largely contributed;

Whereas the tolls constitute a considerable burden upon
the farmers of these two counties and place them at a
disadvantage by increasing the cost to them of the pro-
ducts which they sell in the Montreal market;

Therefore, His Majesty, with the advice and consent of
the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly
of Quebec, enacts as follows:

1. Notwithstanding any provision to the contrary of
any general law or special act, all persons domiciled for
not less than twelve months in the counties of Argenteuil or
Two Mountains and their farm-hands shall be exempt from
the payment of any tolls or dues whatsoever for passing,
with or without a motor or other vehicle, over the bridge
over the river Jésus, situated at St. Eustache, commonly
called "Bellefeuille's Bridge". Exempting of

2. This act shall come into force on the day of its
sanction. Coming into
