



## CHAPTER 39

### An Act respecting the Act 20 George V, chapter 7

*[Assented to, the 12th of April, 1938]*

**HIS MAJESTY**, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

**1.** The act 20 George V, chapter 7, as amended by the 20 Geo. V acts 21 George V, chapter 44; 25-26 George V, chapter 27, <sup>c. 7, s. 2a, added.</sup> and 1 George VI, chapter 35, is again amended by adding thereto, after section 2 thereof, the following section:

**"2a.** The Lieutenant-Governor in Council may, upon such conditions as he may determine, authorize the Minister of Agriculture to acquire, for the storing of agricultural products, the immoveable comprising a building or construction mentioned in a deed passed before F. S. MacKay, Notary, on the 30th of August, 1934, under the number 17227 of his minutes and situated on St. Ambroise street, in St. Henri ward of the city of Montreal.

If, for any reason whatsoever, such immoveable cannot, in the opinion of the Lieutenant-Governor in Council, be acquired by private agreement, he may authorize the Minister of Agriculture to become the purchaser thereof in accordance with the provisions hereinafter contained in this section.

The Minister shall give notice, by registered mail, to their last address known to him, to the owner of the immoveable mentioned in this section and to the person or persons who appear to have an option on such immoveable, that he intends to acquire it at the price mentioned in an

option signed by the president and the secretary of Lake of the Woods Milling Company, Limited, on or about the 3rd of February, 1938.

The Minister shall deposit a copy of such notice, for registration, in the office of the registration division of Montreal and, counting from such deposit, the immoveable properties in question in this section shall become the absolute and indefeasible property of the Government of this Province and shall be freed from all the real rights which affected them.

The Minister shall, out of the sum mentioned in section 2, pay the purchase price of such immoveable properties.

Such payment may, as the Lieutenant-Governor in Council shall decide, be made to the company above-mentioned or to the person or persons holding an option on such immoveable properties or to their assigns."

Coming into  
force.

**2.** This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction.
