



CHAPTER 54

An Act respecting the improvement of public bridges

[Assented to, the 18th of March, 1938]

HIS MAJESTY, with the advice and consent of the
Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly
of Quebec, enacts as follows:

1. From and after the coming into force of this act and notwithstanding any general law or special act to the contrary, all bridges having a clear span, between the abutments, of at least fifteen feet, and built, repaired or maintained with aid from the Government of this Province, shall be so built, repaired or maintained under the supervision, control and authority of the Minister of Public Works and according to plans and specifications approved by him.
