



CHAPTER 55

An Act to aid the maple sugar industry

[Assented to, the 12th of April, 1938]

HIS MAJESTY, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

1. The Lieutenant-Governor in Council may, upon the recommendation of the Minister of Agriculture and of the Minister of Municipal Affairs, Trade and Commerce, enter into any agreement which he may deem in the interest of the Province, with any person, firm, corporation, institution or government, to aid in the development of the maple sugar industry and in the solution of the problems relating thereto.

2. The Government of the Province is authorized to take any measure it may deem necessary for the carrying out of this act and of the agreements entered into under the authority of section 1.

3. The Lieutenant-Governor in Council may, for the purposes above contemplated, authorize the Provincial Treasurer to pay, out of the consolidated revenue fund, an amount not exceeding two hundred thousand dollars.

4. This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction.
