



## CHAPTER 56

An Act to promote the establishing and developing of the  
apple cider industry in this Province

*[Assented to, the 12th of April, 1938]*

**HIS MAJESTY**, with the advice and consent of the  
Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly  
of Quebec, enacts as follows:

**1.** Notwithstanding any provision to the contrary of Lt.-G. in C.  
any general law or special act, the Lieutenant-Governor <sup>and regula-</sup>  
in Council, within the limits of the powers conferred upon <sup>tions for cider</sup>  
the Legislature by the Constitution of Canada, may make re-  
gulations for the manufacture and sale of cider in this  
Province, fix the duties on this manufacture and sale and  
enact penalties for infringements of the regulations adopted  
under the authority of this act.

**2.** This act shall come into force on the day of its <sup>Coming into</sup>  
sanction. <sup>force.</sup>
