



CHAPTER 69

An Act respecting the Roman Catholic and Protestant school municipalities of Val d'Or

[Assented to, the 8th of April, 1938]

HIS MAJESTY, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

1. The school municipality of the town of Bourlamaque, as it existed prior to the passing of the act 1 George VI, chapter 70, is reëstablished and the territory forming the town of Bourlamaque is in consequence detached from the Roman Catholic and Protestant school municipalities of Val d'Or. Detaching of certain territory.

2. The new school corporation of the town of Bourlamaque shall reimburse to each of the Roman Catholic and Protestant school corporations of Val d'Or the expenditure incurred by each of them from the 1st of July, 1937, to the 1st of July, 1938, for the exclusive benefit of the territory forming the new school municipality of the town of Bourlamaque. Reimbursing of certain expenditure.

3. The new school corporation of the town of Bourlamaque shall also reimburse to each of the Roman Catholic and Protestant school corporations of Val d'Or, but only *pro rata* of the valuation of the real estate situated in the territory forming the school municipality of the town of Bourlamaque, the expenditure incurred by each of them from the 1st of July, 1937, to the 1st of July, 1938, for the common benefit of the territory forming, prior to the coming into force of this act, the Roman Catholic and Protestant school municipalities of Val d'Or. Pro rata reimbursing of certain expenditure.

4. The Quebec Municipal Commission shall have exclusive jurisdiction for the decision of any question relating to the application of sections 2 and 3 of this act and its decisions shall be non-appealable.

5. This act shall come into force on the 1st of July, 1938.
