



CHAPTER 78

An Act to amend the Fire Investigation Act

[Assented to, the 8th of April, 1938]

HIS MAJESTY, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

1. Section 11 of the Fire Investigation Act (Revised Statutes, 1925, chapter 179), as replaced by the act 24 George V, chapter 53, section 1, is amended by adding thereto the following paragraph:

“There shall also be in the city of Montreal an officer called the Assistant Fire Commissioner of Montreal.”

2. Section 12 of the said act is amended by adding thereto, after the word: “Quebec”, in the third line of the first paragraph thereof, the words: “, and an assistant fire commissioner in the city of Montreal”.

3. Section 14 of the said act is amended by adding thereto the following paragraph:

Id., s. 14, am.

“The provisions of the preceding paragraph shall apply to the Assistant Fire Commissioner of Montreal, in the case of the death, absence or disability of the commissioner and whenever the latter shall call upon him to act in his stead.”

Application.

4. Section 26 of the said act is amended:

R.S., c. 179, s. 26, am.

a. By replacing the word: “six”, in the third line of the first paragraph thereof, by the word: “five”;

b. By replacing the words: “, to be divided equally between the incumbents of the said office, so long as the said office is held by more than one person and not more than

two, to", in the third, fourth and fifth lines of the said first paragraph thereof, by the words: "and the assistant commissioner shall be entitled to an annual salary of three thousand dollars, which salaries shall";

c. By striking out the words: "and shall be divided equally between the incumbents of such office so long as the said office is held by more than one person and not more than two," in the fourth, fifth and sixth lines of the second paragraph thereof;

d. By replacing the word: "two-thirds", in the fourth line of the fourth paragraph thereof, by the word: "three-fourths".

Coming into
force.

5. This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction.
