



CHAPTER 81

An Act to repeal Section 24 of the Act 14 George V, chapter 53, and Section 316 of the Notarial Code, respecting the validity of certain notarial deeds

[Assented to, the 12th of April, 1938]

HIS MAJESTY, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

1. Section 24 of the act 14 George V, chapter 53, and section 316 of the Notarial Code (Revised Statutes, 1925, chapter 211, as enacted by the act 23 George V, chapter 80, section 1), are repealed. Provisions repealed.

2. The provisions of section 1 of this act and the repeal of section 315 of the Notarial Code by the said act 23 George V, chapter 80, section 1, shall be in effect as from the 15th of March, 1924. Retro-activity.

3. The rights and recourses extinguished or affected in any manner whatsoever consequent upon the putting into force of the said section 24 of the said act 14 George V, chapter 53, of the said section 315 of the Notarial Code as it existed prior to the act 23 George V, chapter 80, and of the said section 316 of the Notarial Code as enacted by the said act 23 George V, chapter 80, are restored in their entirety, in the state in which they were on the 14th of March, 1924. Restoring of certain rights and recourses.

Such rights and recourses shall be prescribed by five years counting from the date of the coming into force of this act. Prescription.

4. This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction. Coming into force.
