



CHAPTER 99

An Act to replace Article 1641a of the Civil Code

[Assented to, the 12th of April, 1938]

HIS MAJESTY, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

1. Article 1641a of the Civil Code, as enacted by the C. C., art. act 24 George V, chapter 75, section 1, and as replaced 1641a, re- placed. by the act 25-26 George V, chapter 93, section 1, is again replaced by the following:

“**1641a.** A lessee, on the Island of Montreal, is bound ^{Visiting, etc.} to permit the visiting, for leasing purposes, of the leased ^{period on} dwelling, and the affixing on the front of such dwelling of ^{Island of} signs for such purposes, only during the sixty days preceding ^{Montreal.} the expiration of the lease, unless the said lease contains an agreement to the contrary.”

2. This act shall come into force on the day of its sanc- ^{-Coming into} tion. ^{force.}
