



## CHAPTER 102

An Act to amend Article 1310 of the Code of Civil Procedure

[Assented to, the 12th of April, 1938]

**HIS MAJESTY**, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

- 1.** Article 1310 of the Code of Civil Procedure, as C. C. P., art. amended by the acts 1 George V (2nd Session), chapter 55, <sup>1310, am.</sup> section 1, and 12 George V, chapter 93, section 4, and replaced by the act 14 George V, chapter 71, section 7, is amended by replacing the word: "has", in the second line of the second paragraph thereof, by the words: "and the clerk of the Circuit Court in and for the county of Pontiac, sitting at the village of Chapeau, have".
- 2.** The provisions of section 1 shall be in effect as <sup>Retro-</sup> from the 21st of March, 1922. <sup>activity.</sup>
- 3.** This act shall come into force on the day of its <sup>Coming into</sup> sanction. <sup>force.</sup>
