



CHAPTER 110

An Act respecting the city of Sherbrooke

[Assented to, the 12th of April, 1938]

HIS MAJESTY, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

1. Section 57 of the act 1 George VI, chapter 105, is amended: ^{1 Geo. VI,}

a. By striking out the second paragraph of section 521 of the Cities and Towns' Act, as replaced, for the city of Sherbrooke, by the said section 57 of the said act 1 George VI, chapter 105;

b. By adding thereto, after the word: "equipment", at the end of the third paragraph thereof, the words: "which has become immoveable and which may be taxed if the council so decide".

2. The provisions of section 1 shall be in effect as from the 20th of May, 1937. ^{Retro-}
