



CHAPTER 119

An Act respecting the municipal corporation of the west
part of the township of Farnham

[Assented to, the 12th of April, 1938]

WHEREAS the municipal corporation of the west part Preamble.
of the township of Farnham is under the control
of the Quebec Municipal Commission:

Whereas certain persons contend that they have against
it claims which such corporation denies as unfounded;

Whereas the Quebec Municipal Commission will be pre-
vented from efficaciously reorganizing the finances of the
said corporation until such time as it can ascertain the
total amount of the obligations of the corporation;

Whereas it is expedient to adopt measures so that this
situation be settled within a reasonable delay and in a man-
ner equitable for all the interested parties;

Therefore, His Majesty, with the advice and consent
of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly
of Quebec enacts as follows:

last known address of such person and must be accom- given.
panied by a copy of this act, certified by the secretary-trea-
surer of the corporation.

Delay for
instituting
legal action.

2. Any person pretending to have a claim against the said corporation and who has received the notice contemplated under section 1 must, under penalty of forfeiture of his recourse, institute legal action, in the usual manner, within the twelve months following the mailing of such notice.

Provisions
not applic-
able.

3. The provisions of section 38 of the Quebec Municipal Commission Act (22 George V, chapter 56), as amended by the acts 23 George V, chapter 50, section 4, and 24 George V, chapter 35, section 2, shall not apply in the cases contemplated under section 2, except with respect to execution of judgment.

Coming into

4. This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction.
