



CHAPTER 124

An Act to amend the charter of the Quebec Western Railway Company

[Assented to, the 12th of April, 1938]

WHEREAS the Quebec Western Railway Company Preamble.
has, by its petition, represented that it is expedient
that the delay, fixed by its charter to begin constructing
its line, be extended, and has, by such petition, prayed for
the passing of an act to amend its charter, the act 1 George
VI, chapter 131; and whereas it is expedient to grant its
prayer;

Therefore, His Majesty, with the advice and consent of
the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of
Quebec, enacts as follows:

1. Section 13 of the act 1 George VI, chapter 131, is 1 Geo. VI,
c. 131, s. 13,
replaced.
replaced by the following:

“13. Section 180 of the said Quebec Railway Act is R. S., c. 230,
s. 180, replac-
ed for com-
pany.
replaced, for the company, by the following:

“180. If the construction of the railway be not com-
menced and if one-third of the total amount of the capital
subscribed be not expended thereon, within eighteen
months after the granting of the charter, and if the railway
be not finished and put in operation within four years
from the granting of such charter, the powers of the com-
pany shall cease and be null and void.” Delay, etc.,
