



## CHAPTER 124

### An Act to amend the charter of the Quebec Western Railway Company

[Assented to, the 12th of April, 1938]

**WHEREAS** the Quebec Western Railway Company Preamble.  
has, by its petition, represented that it is expedient  
that the delay, fixed by its charter to begin constructing  
its line, be extended, and has, by such petition, prayed for  
the passing of an act to amend its charter, the act 1 George  
VI, chapter 131; and whereas it is expedient to grant its  
prayer;

Therefore, His Majesty, with the advice and consent of  
the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of  
Quebec, enacts as follows:

**1.** Section 13 of the act 1 George VI, chapter 131, is 1 Geo. VI,

from the granting of such charter, the powers of the com-
