



## CHAPTER 125

### An Act to amend the charter of the Temiscamingue and Abitibi Railway Company

[Assented to, the 8th of April, 1938]

**W**HEREAS the Temiscamingue and Abitibi Railway Company has, by its petition, represented that it is expedient that the delay fixed by its charter for the commencement of the construction of its line be extended, and has, by such petition, prayed for the passing of an act to amend its charter, the act 1 George VI, chapter 133; and

Whereas it is expedient to grant its prayer;

Therefore, His Majesty, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

**1.** Section 12 of the act 1 George VI, chapter 133, is replaced by the following:

1 Geo. VI,

**"12.** The company shall construct its railway by commencing with the Angliers section, and this within a delay not exceeding twenty-four months from the date of the coming into force of this act, the said section to be terminated prior to the 1st of October, 1941."
