



## CHAPTER 143

### An Act respecting the adoption of Juanita Elinor Hamilton-Jackson

*[Assented to, the 8th of April, 1938]*

**WHEREAS** Clement H. Cronyn, secretary, of the city of Preamble.

Westmount, is desirous of adopting his step-daughter, known as Juanita Elinor Hamilton-Jackson, but according to her birth certificate named Juanita Eleanor Jackson, spinster of the age of majority, of the city of Westmount, daughter by a former marriage of his late wife, Constance Elizabeth Rhynas Pinhey, who has been brought up and considered by him as his own child; and

Whereas Juanita Elinor Hamilton-Jackson is desirous of being adopted by her step-father Clement H. Cronyn and is also desirous of changing her name to Juanita Elinor Cronyn; and

Whereas Clement H. Cronyn and Juanita Elinor Hamilton-Jackson have prayed for the passing of an act accordingly and it is expedient to grant the said prayer;

Therefore, His Majesty, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

**1.** The said Juanita Elinor Hamilton-Jackson or Juanita Eleanor Jackson shall hereafter be deemed for all purposes to be the adopted daughter of the said Clement H. Cronyn, enjoying all the rights and privileges granted to a child adopted under the Adoption Act, and she shall hereafter bear his surname and be known by the name of Juanita Elinor Cronyn; but this shall not affect any rights she here- Adoption of Juanita Eleanor Jackson, and change of name.
