WHEREAS section 173 of chapter 102 of the Revised Statutes of Quebec, 1925, enacts that the Lieutenant-Governor in Council, upon application from a city or town municipality, may change, by letters patent, the date of the general elections of mayor and aldermen of the said municipality;

Whereas the general election for mayor and aldermen is, for the town of Pointe-aux-Trembles, actually fixed for the first juridical day of February;

Whereas the council of the town of Pointe-aux-Trembles, in a resolution adopted on the 16th of February, 1937, has expressed its desire that the date of the elections be changed;

Whereas the said resolution indicates the first juridical Monday of October as being the most convenient date for the holding of the general election of mayor and aldermen for the town of Pointe-aux-Trembles, and that it requests the issue of letters patent to that effect;

THEREFORE, with the advice and consent of Our Executive Council expressed in an order dated the 11th of June, 1937, and in conformity with section 173 of chapter 102 of the Revised Statutes of Quebec, 1925, We have fixed and by these present Letters Patent do fix the date of the general election of mayor and aldermen in the town of Pointe-aux-Trembles, county of Hochelaga, for the first juridical Monday of October instead of the first juridical day of February.

OF ALL WHICH Our loving subjects and all others whom these presents may concern are hereby required to take notice and to govern themselves accordingly.

IN TESTIMONY WHEREOF, We have caused these Our Letters to be made Patent and the Great Seal of Our Province of Quebec to be hereunto affixed. WITNESS: Our Right Trusty and Well Beloved the Honourable ÉSIOFF-LÉON PATENAUDE, Member of Our Privy Council of Canada, Lieutenant-Governor of Our Province of Quebec.

At Our Government House, in Our City of QUEBEC, in Our said Province, this SECOND day of JULY, in the year of Our Lord one thousand nine hundred and thirty-seven and in the first year of Our Reign.
