



CHAPTER 14

An Act to detach certain territory from the municipality of St. Ephrem de Tring, in the electoral district of Beauce, to annex it to the municipality of St. Méthode d'Adstock, in the electoral district of Frontenac

[Assented to, the 17th of May, 1937]

HIS MAJESTY, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows :

1. The following territory is detached from the municipality of the parish of St. Ephrem de Tring, in the electoral district of Beauce, and annexed to the municipality of the parish of St. Méthode d'Adstock, in the electoral district of Frontenac, for all parochial, school, municipal, electoral, judicial and registration purposes, namely:

a. The lots designated under the numbers 529, 529a, 530, 531, 532, 533, 534, 535 and 536 of the official plan and book of reference of the cadastre of the parish of St. Ephrem de Tring, corresponding to the original lots numbers 15, 16 and 17 and the southeast part of the original lot number 18 of range XI of the township of Tring;

b. A part of the by-road of eleventh range measuring from the dividing line of the townships of Tring and Adstock, a distance of fifteen arpents in a northeasterly direction.

2. Notwithstanding any provision to the contrary of any act, the corporation of the parish of St. Ephrem

de Tring and the corporation of the parish of St. Méthode d'Adstock shall be specially charged with the maintenance of the said by-road, each for the portion situated within its respective territory.

Maintaining

3. The front road between ranges X and XI, from the northwestern line of lot No. 536 of the official cadastre of the parish of St. Ephrem de Tring as far as the by-road of the said range XI, shall remain a charge upon the bordering owners, but under the direction and control of the corporation in the territory of which their property is situated.

4. The provisions of the Territorial Division Act (Revised Statutes, 1925, chapter 2) are amended accordingly.

5. This act shall come into force on such date as it may please the Lieutenant-Governor in Council to fix by proclamation.
