



CHAPTER 15

An Act to detach certain territory from the municipality of St. Edouard de Frampton and to annex it to the municipality of St. Joseph de Beauce

[Assented to, the 17th of May, 1937]

HIS MAJESTY, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows :

1. The following territory is detached from the municipality of the parish of St. Edouard de Frampton, in the electoral district of Dorchester, and annexed to the municipality of the parish of St. Joseph de Beauce, in the electoral district of Beauce, for all parochial, school, municipal, electoral, judicial and registration purposes, namely:

The territory comprising, referring to the official cadastre of the parish of St. Edouard de Frampton in the county of Dorchester, the lots numbers 98, 100, 102, 104, 106, 107, 109, 112, 113, 114, 116, 118, 120, 124, 126, 128, 130, 133, 135, 137, 139 and 140 of the 1st range of the said parish of St. Edouard de Frampton, bounded on the northeast by the front road of the first range of St. Edouard de Frampton and by the northeastern line of the lots numbers 130, 133, 135, 137, 139 and 140 of the said first range of St. Edouard de Frampton; on the southwest by the line separating the said first range of St. Edouard de Frampton from the St. Thomas range of the parish of St. Joseph de Beauce; on the southeast by the southeastern line of the said lot number 140 of the first range, and on the northwest by the northwestern line of the said lot number 98 of the first range of St. Edouard de Frampton.

Maintaining
of certain
front road. **2.** Notwithstanding any provision to the contrary,
the front road of the first range of St. Edouard de
Frampton shall, as in the past, be maintained and re-
paired by the property-owners who were liable for its
maintenance, but under the direction and control of the
corporation in the territory whereof their immoveables
will now be situated in virtue of this act.

Provisions
amended. **3.** The provisions of the Territorial Division Act
(Revised Statutes, 1925, chapter 2) are amended ac-
cordingly.

Coming into
force. **4.** This act shall come into force on such date as
it may please the Lieutenant-Governor in Council to
fix by proclamation.
