



CHAPTER 16

An Act to detach certain lots from the electoral district of Rimouski and to annex them to the municipality of the parish of Saint-Michel-du-Squatec, in the electoral district of Témiscouata

[Assented to, the 20th of May, 1937]

HIS MAJESTY, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

1. The territory, formed of a part of the township of Biencourt, comprising the lots No. 51 to No. 57 inclusive, in each of the 1st, 2nd, 3rd, 4th, 5th, 6th, 7th and 8th ranges of the original subdivision of the said township, and bounded on the northwest by the division line of the townships of Bédard and Biencourt; on the southeast by the outer southeast line of the township of Biencourt; on the northeast by the division lines of lots Nos. 50 and 51 in each of the above ranges; on the southwest by the division line of the townships of Robitaille and Biencourt also dividing the electoral districts of Rimouski and Témiscouata —, which territory forms part of no local municipality,— is detached from the electoral district of Rimouski and annexed to the municipality of the parish of Saint-Michel-du-Squatec, in the electoral district of Témiscouata, for all parish, school, municipal, electoral, judicial and registration purposes.
