



CHAPTER 17

An Act to amend the Legislature Act

[Assented to, the 27th of May, 1937]

HIS MAJESTY, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows :

1. Section 66 of the Legislature Act (Revised Statutes, 1925, chapter 3), as amended by the acts 17 George V, chapter 13, section 3; 18 George V, chapter 12, section 3; 20 George V, chapter 19, section 65; 21 George V, chapter 19, section 1; 25-26 George V, chapter 11, section 1; 25-26 George V, chapter 45, section 1, and 1 Edward VIII (2nd Session), chapter 20, section 1, is again amended by adding thereto, after subsection 2 thereof, the following subsection :

"3. The fees, emoluments or disbursements claimed or received by a physician for professional services rendered, in the course of his practice, to indigent persons or to settlers, and those received in such capacity for services given in the practice of the medical profession in any institution subsidized by the Government of this Province, shall not be a cause for disqualification within the meaning of section 65, nor entail any disqualification, notwithstanding any general law or special act to the contrary."

Fees, etc., not occasioning disqualification.

2. This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction."
