



CHAPTER 18

An Act to amend the Quebec Election Act

[Assented to, the 27th of May, 1937]

HIS MAJESTY, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

1. Section 13 of the Quebec Election Act (1 Edward VIII (2nd Session), chapter 8) is amended:

a. By striking out the words: "crown prosecutors," in the fifth line of paragraph 1 thereof;

b. By replacing paragraph 6 thereof by the following:

"6. Interdicted persons and the insane hospitalized in an asylum or in a nursing home."

2. Section 48 of the said act is amended by inserting therein, after the word: "for", in the second line of the first paragraph thereof, the words: "Quebec and for".

3. Section 123 of the said act is amended by adding thereto, after the second paragraph thereof, the following paragraph:

"Nor may the following persons vote at an election: any person who, since the date fixed for the issuing of the writ for such election, has committed or participated in the committing of any fraudulent act."

4. This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction.
