



## CHAPTER 18

### An Act to amend the Quebec Election Act

*[Assented to, the 27th of May, 1937]*

**HIS MAJESTY**, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

**1.** Section 13 of the Quebec Election Act (1 Edward VIII (2nd Session), chapter 8) is amended:

a. By striking out the words: "crown prosecutors," in the fifth line of paragraph 1 thereof;

b. By replacing paragraph 6 thereof by the following:

"6. Interdicted persons and the insane hospitalized in an asylum or in a nursing home."

**2.** Section 48 of the said act is amended by inserting therein, after the word: "for", in the second line of the first paragraph thereof, the words: "Quebec and for".

**3.** Section 123 of the said act is amended by adding thereto, after the second paragraph thereof, the following paragraph:

"Nor may the following persons vote at an election: any person who, since the date fixed for the issuing of the writ for such election, has committed or participated in the committing of any fraudulent act."

**4.** This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction.
