



CHAPTER 22

An Act to guarantee the independence of the Quebec Liquor Commission

[Assented to, the 27th of May, 1937]

HIS MAJESTY, with the advice and consent of the
Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assem-
bly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

1. Section 1 of the Act respecting the Quebec Li-
quor Commission (1 Edward VIII (2nd Session),
chapter 14) is amended by adding thereto the follow-
ing paragraph:

“The Quebec Liquor Commission created by the
act 11 George V, chapter 24, is and has always been
a corporation vested with all the rights and powers be-
longing to corporations generally.”

2. Section 2 of the said act is amended:

a. By replacing the words: “Lieutenant-Governor in
Council”, in the third line thereof, by the word: “man-
ager”;

b. By replacing the word: “Commission”, in the
eighth line thereof, by the words: “Commission; such
salary or remuneration shall, however, be subject to the
approval of the Lieutenant-Governor in Council when-
ever he may so enact”;

c. By adding thereto the following paragraph:

“The Lieutenant-Governor in Council may, however,
upon the recommendation of the manager, appoint an
assistant-manager, who must reside in the district of
Quebec and who shall have the functions and duties

attributed to him by the manager. The remuneration of the assistant-manager shall be fixed by the Lieutenant-Governor in Council and be paid out of the revenues of the Quebec Liquor Commission."

Coming into force. **3.** This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction.
