



CHAPTER 23

An Act to amend the Alcoholic Liquor Act

[Assented to, the 14th of April, 1937]

HIS MAJESTY, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows :

1. Section 37 of the Alcoholic Liquor Act (Revised R.S., c. 37, Statutes, 1925, chapter 37), as amended by the acts ^{s. 37, am.} 16 George V, chapter 21, section 3; 17 George V, chapter 21, section 2, and 19 George V, chapter 22, section 1, is again amended by adding thereto, at the end thereof, the following paragraph:

"The Lieutenant-Governor in Council may, how- ^{Increasing of} ever, increase, to such amount as he may determine, ^{duties.} the duties contemplated in this section for each class of permit."

2. Section 94 of the said act, as replaced by the act ^{R.S., c. 37,} 24 George V, chapter 17, section 21, is amended: ^{s. 94, am.}

a. By replacing paragraph 1 thereof by the following:

"1. By any person authorized generally by the ^{Taking of} Attorney-General to take such suits or prosecutions ^{suits, etc.} and to sign such complaints; or";

b. By adding thereto, at the end of the said section, the following paragraph:

"A complaint deposited shall make proof of the ^{Complaint} signature of such person or of such collector and of the ^{deposited} authorization conferred upon him by the Attorney- ^{deemed} General under this section, unless the contrary be ^{proof of} established." ^{certain} signature.

3. Section 139 of the said act, as amended by the acts 18 George V, chapter 93, section 7, and 19 George V, chapter 22, section 4, is again amended by replacing the word: "Commission", in the sixth line of the third paragraph of subsection 6 thereof, by the word: "Crown".
