



CHAPTER 31

An Act respecting lands held under location tickets

[Assented to, the 24th of March, 1937]

HIS MAJESTY, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

1. Notwithstanding any provision to the contrary of any general law or special act, the public lands within the meaning of the Lands and Forests Act (Revised Statutes, 1925, chapter 44), which will be placed under the control and administration of the Minister of Colonization, shall be excluded, after the date of the location ticket, from any license to cut timber. Exclusion of certain public lands from license to cut timber.

2. This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction. Coming into force.
