



CHAPTER 40

An Act to provide for the protection of colonization roads

[Assented to, the 17th of May, 1937]

HIS MAJESTY, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows :

1. The Colonization Roads Act (Revised Statutes, R.S., c. 76, 1925, chapter 76) is amended by adding thereto, after ss. 8a, 8b, section 8 thereof, the following Division and sections:

"DIVISION IIa

"PROTECTION OF COLONIZATION ROADS

"**8a.** Whenever work is being carried out on a colonization road, the Minister may prohibit or restrict the circulation of vehicles on such road. Prohibiting, etc., circulation on certain roads.

He may also, in order to protect such road during the thawing period or during a rainy period, prohibit, for such time as he may deem necessary, the circulation of any vehicle having a total weight, load included, of over two thousand pounds. Id., of vehicles having a certain weight.

"**8b.** Any person making use of a vehicle in contravention of a prohibition enacted under section 8a commits an infringement and renders himself liable to a fine not exceeding fifty dollars and costs, and, in default of payment of such fine and costs, to an imprisonment not exceeding one month." Offence and penalty.

2. This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction. Coming into force.
