



## CHAPTER 52

An Act to amend the Cities and Towns' Act respecting  
the valuation of new or improved property

[Assented to, the 20th of May, 1937]

**H**IS MAJESTY, with the advice and consent of the  
Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly  
of Quebec, enacts as follows :

**1.** The Cities and Towns' Act (Revised Statutes, R. S., c. 102,  
1925, chapter 102) is amended by inserting therein, s. 488a,  
added. after section 488 thereof, the following section :

"**488a.** In order to aid any proprietor wishing to Maintaining  
of municipal  
valuation  
at certain  
sum. repair, improve or rebuild his house, the council may  
maintain, during a period not exceeding five years,  
the municipal valuation at the value entered in the  
valuation roll at the time of the commencing of the  
repair or rebuilding work. Nevertheless, the above Proviso.  
benefit shall not be accorded to the proprietor increas-  
ing by such work the number of lodgings contained in  
the house."

**2.** The provisions of section 1 of this act shall apply Application  
of section 1. to every municipal corporation whether governed by a  
general law or by a special act.

**3.** This act shall come into force on the day of its Coming into  
force. sanction.
