



## CHAPTER 62

### An Act respecting municipal tax exemptions

[Assented to, the 24th of March, 1937]

**HIS MAJESTY**, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows :

**1.** Section 3 of the Municipal Aid Prohibition Act, R. S., 1925, (Revised Statutes, 1925, chapter 116), as replaced by <sup>c. 116, s. 3,</sup> the act 16 George V, chapter 34, section 3, is repealed. <sup>repealed.</sup>

**2.** Section 4 of the said act, as replaced by the act 16 <sup>Id., s. 4,</sup> George V, chapter 34, section 3, is again replaced by <sup>replaced.</sup> the following:

**“4.** An action to quash a by-law or resolution, <sup>Prosecution</sup> passed by any municipal council contrary to the pro- <sup>for infringe-</sup> hibition contained in section 2, may be instituted <sup>ment.</sup> against the municipality by a ratepayer, by any interested person or by the Minister of Municipal Affairs, Trade and Commerce.”

**3.** The act 21 George V, chapter 119, is repealed. <sup>21 Geo. V, c. 119, repeal-</sup>

**4.** This act shall come into force on the 1st of June, <sup>ed.</sup> 1937. <sup>Coming into force.</sup>
