



CHAPTER 63

An Act respecting the *Congrès du parler français* of 1937, the salaries of rural teachers and education generally

[Assented to, the 27th of May, 1937]

HIS MAJESTY, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

1. The Government of the Province is authorized to expend an amount of twenty thousand dollars, whereof fifteen thousand dollars may be employed to subsidize the organization of the *Congrès du parler français* of 1937, and five thousand dollars to pay the expenditure occasioned to the Government by reason of such *congrès*. Expenditure authorized for Congrès du parler français.

2. An annual fund of eighty-five thousand dollars is created and the Lieutenant-Governor in Council is authorized to appropriate such fund for the purpose of constructing or repairing schools or teaching establishments. Creation of fund for repairing, etc., schools, etc.

The grants arising from such fund shall be accorded upon the conditions determined by the Lieutenant-Governor in Council, upon the recommendation of the Superintendent of Education. Utilization of such fund.

3. An amount of four hundred thousand dollars to be used to aid rural school corporations to augment the salaries of their male and female teachers is placed annually at the disposal of the Government. Amount to aid rural teachers.

The Lieutenant-Governor in Council, upon the recommendation of the Superintendent of Education, shall determine the conditions to which the according of such grants shall be subject.

4. Section 11 of the Education Act (Revised Statutes, 1925, chapter 133) is amended by replacing the word: "six", in the fifth line of paragraph 1 thereof, by the word: "seven".

5. The amounts contemplated in the preceding sections 1, 2 and 3 shall be paid out of the consolidated revenue fund.

Loans au-
thorized.

The Lieutenant-Governor in Council may, however, order the complete or partial payment of such amounts by means of loans not exceeding thirty years and bearing interest at rates not exceeding four per cent per annum.

6. This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction.
