



CHAPTER 71

An Act respecting the Roman Catholic and Protestant school municipalities of the town of Val d'Or

[Assented to, the 27th of May, 1937]

HIS MAJESTY, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

1. The Roman Catholic school municipality of Val d'Or and the Protestant school municipality of Val d'Or are, during one year from the date of the coming into force of this act, placed under the control and supervision of the Quebec Municipal Commission which, for the exercise of such control and supervision, possesses and exercises all the powers and attributions conferred upon it by the Quebec Municipal Commission Act (Revised Statutes, 1925, chapter 111A, as enacted by the act 22 George V, chapter 56) and the amendments thereto, and this notwithstanding any provisions to the contrary of the said Quebec Municipal Commission Act.

Placing of certain school municipalities under control of Quebec Municipal Commission.

2. This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction.
